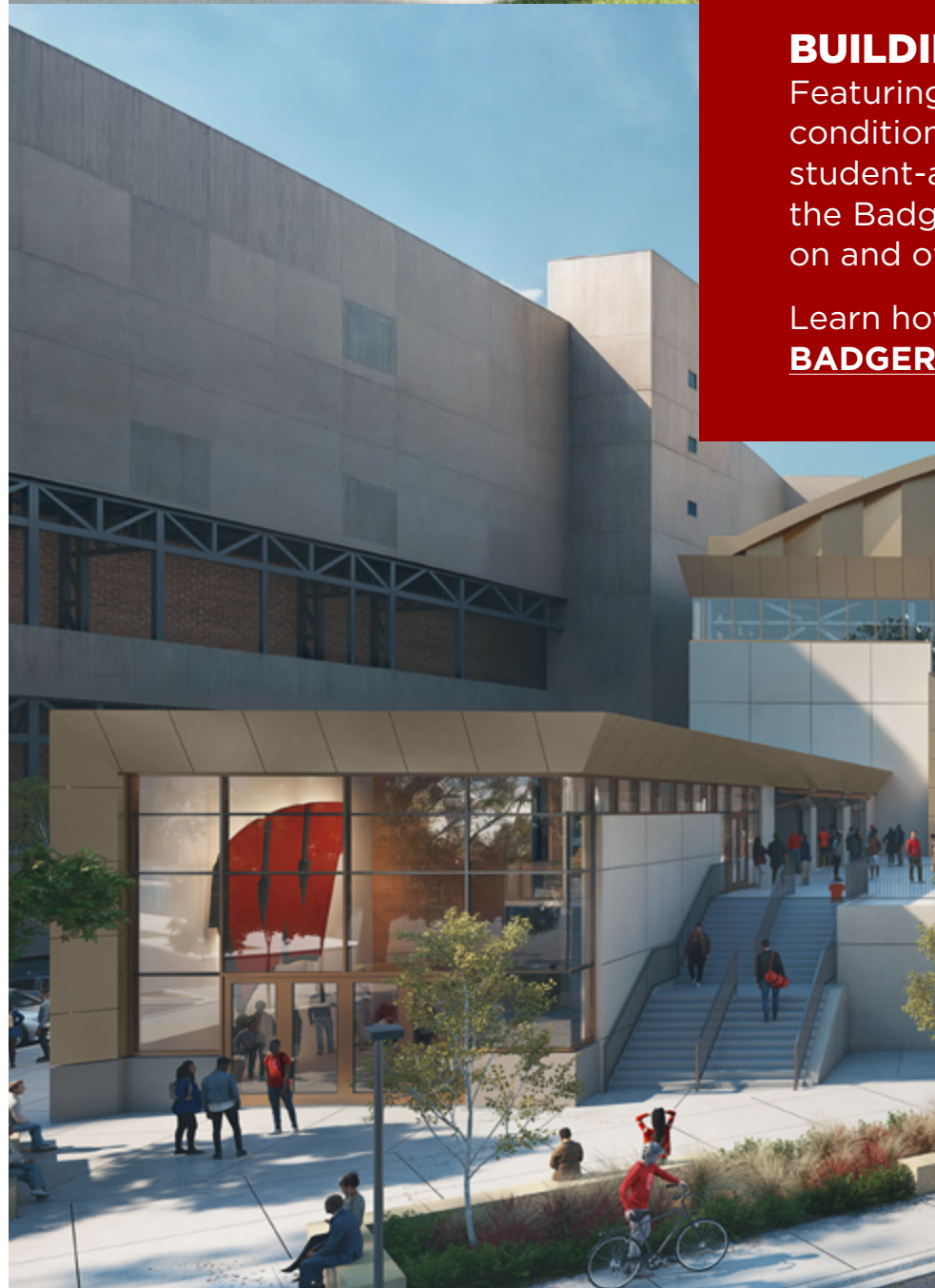

BADGER SELECT RANK is based on 2025 Annual Giving Level & Badger Select priority points. Badger Select priority points include: points as of December 31, 2017 plus 2018-25 priority points accrued from non-deductible donations (those associated with seating and Badger Select seating contributions).

For Badger Select rank, 100% deductible donations made in 2018-25 will NOT be allocated towards Badger Select priority points per IRS policy.

CURRENT SEASON TICKET HOLDERS

Fans who submit payment in full for season tickets and applicable contributions by each sport's deadline will automatically be assigned a personalized selection date and time based on Badger Select Rank: 2025 annual giving level and priority points. Eligible season ticket holders will receive an email with their personalized selection date and time approximately one week prior to the start of Badger Select for each sport.





Badger Select gives season ticket holders the opportunity to view all available seats online. Based on availability, fans can move and improve existing seats, add additional season tickets and purchase season parking (if eligible). Badger Select is used for season parking selection for football (Red & White Club donors - \$250 & higher) and men's basketball (Walk-On Club donors - \$50 & higher).

Please note: Badger Select is an optional benefit available to all current season ticket holders. If you don't want to move your season tickets, add new seats or purchase season parking, you don't have to log in to Badger Select. Simply continue to order your season tickets by each sport's deadline.



NEW SEASON TICKET HOLDERS:

Based on availability, new season ticket holders will have the opportunity to move or add season tickets in Badger Select, as well as purchase season parking for football and men's basketball.

-  Patrons who requested football season tickets by March 15 will be assigned a personalized selection date and time based on Badger Select Rank. (Football parking eligibility: Red & White Club donors - \$250 & higher).
-  Patrons who requested volleyball season tickets by May 16 will be assigned a personalized selection date and time based on Badger Select Rank.
-  Patrons who purchased men's hockey season tickets by June 20 will be assigned a personalized selection date and time based on Badger Select Rank.
-  Patrons who purchased men's basketball season tickets by July 23 will be assigned a personalized selection date and time based on Badger Select Rank. (Men's basketball parking eligibility: Walk-On Club donors - \$50 and higher).

2025 FOOTBALL SEASON TICKETS

STEPS TO BECOME A FOOTBALL SEASON TICKET HOLDER:

1. Purchase **NEW** 2025 football season tickets online at UWBADGERS.COM, by calling the Wisconsin Athletic Ticket Office at **608.262.1440** or completing an interest form to have a representative contact you [HERE](#). Deadline to purchase new football season tickets in **March 15, 2025**.
2. All fans purchasing new season tickets will have the opportunity to participate in Badger Select Football which will run **April 29 - May 16**.

Badger Select Football is the online season ticket and parking selection process, where you will have the opportunity to upgrade your seat locations and select season parking based on availability. You will receive a personalized selection date and time based on your Badger Select Rank approximately one week prior to the start of Badger Select Football. (See Badger Select Page 10).

To be eligible for season parking, you must be a football season ticket holder and active donor to Wisconsin Athletics at the Red & White Club (\$250) or higher by March, 15, 2025. (See Football Parking Page 14).

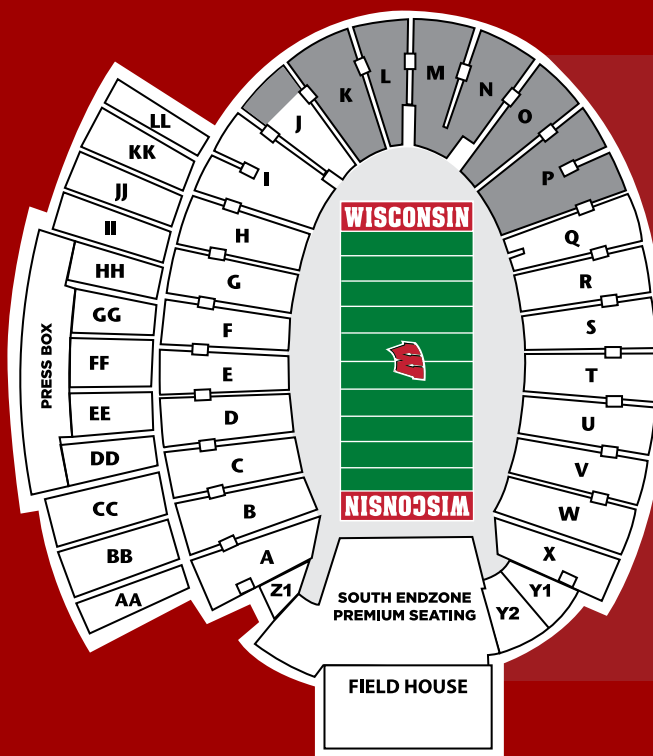

FOOTBALL PARKING

STEPS TO ORDER SEASON PARKING:

1. Fans wishing to be eligible to order season parking must be a football season ticket holder and active donor to Wisconsin Athletics at the Red & White Club (\$250) or higher. Patrons must submit their contribution by **March 15, 2025**.
2. Making a contribution does not guarantee allocation into a certain lot or zone. Patrons ordering multiple parking passes (max. 3) must qualify for each pass.

Example: Ordering two Zone A football parking passes would require a minimum qualifying donation of \$20,000 [\$10,000 per pass].
3. Eligible donors and season ticket holders will receive personalized date and selection time via email approximately one week prior to the start of Badger Select for football, taking place **April 29-May 16**.

Please note: Eligibility for each zone does not guarantee lot availability at the time of your selection in Badger Select. The following Parking Qualifying Gift Amount is the annual donation, per parking pass, to be eligible for each zone:

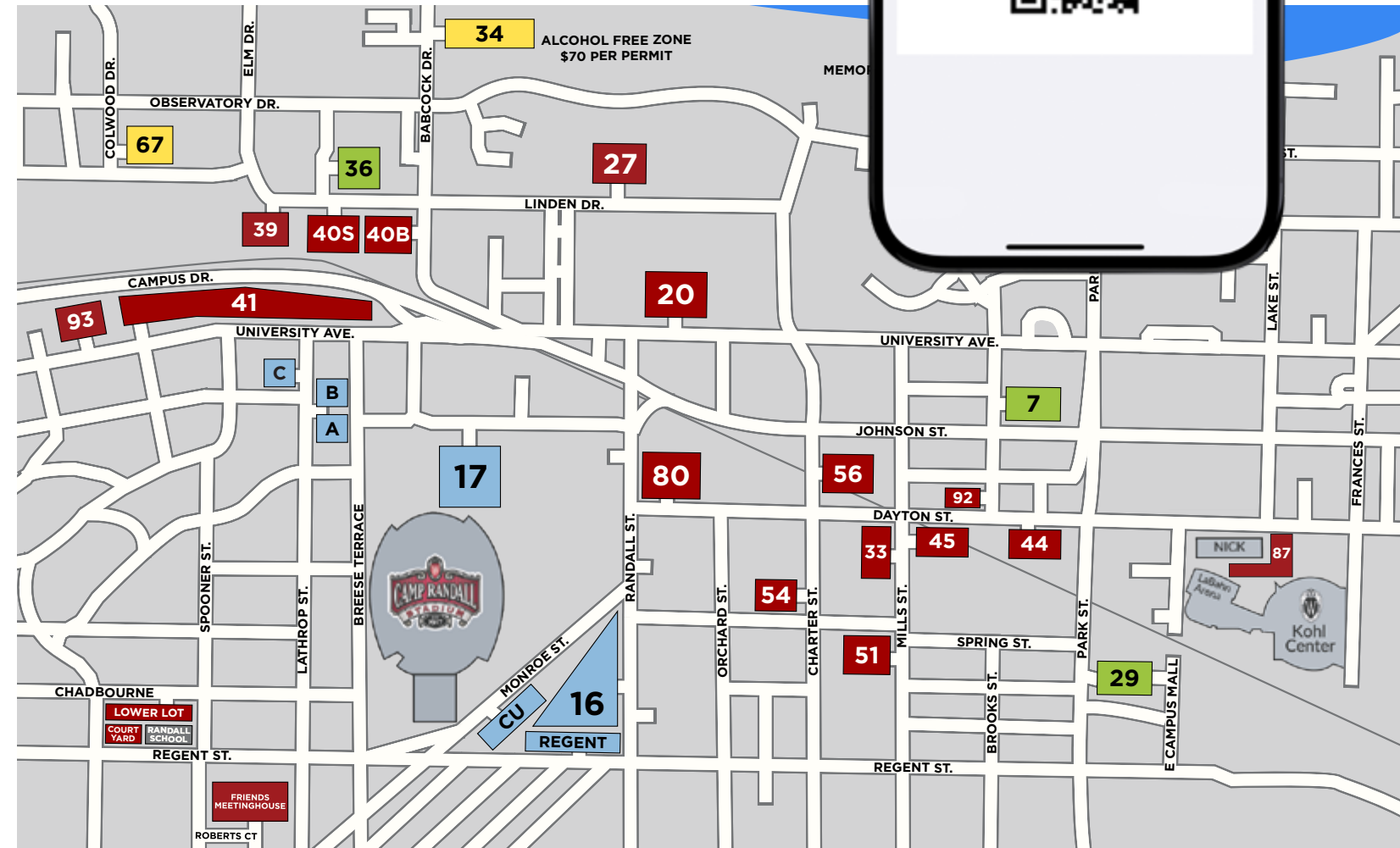

MEN'S BASKETBALL TICKETS & PARKING

CURRENT SEASON TICKET HOLDERS:

Thank you to those who participated in the feasibility study for Kohl Center sports last fall. Based on the results of this study, consideration is being given to changing the price of season tickets and recommended minimum per seat contributions (RMPSC) for men's basketball. A final determination on potential changes will be communicated in advance of the men's basketball season ticket order period beginning **June 30**.

Your 2025-26 Donor Contribution Form includes the RMPSC amount for your seats from the 2024-25 season. Those interested in making their contributions for men's basketball RMPSC are able to do so at this time **HERE**. It is suggested to make all applicable contributions by March 15 in order to maximize all donor benefits. All 2025 donor benefits, including Badger Select Football (seat selection & season parking), are based on total contributions by this deadline.

Please note: Should the RMPSC for men's basketball increase for the 2025-26 season, it would be expected that season ticket holders maintain the RMPSC amount for the seats in their section(s) during the season ticket order period beginning **June 30**.

2. After purchasing season tickets, you will have the opportunity to participate in Badger Select for men's hockey, taking place from **July 24-30**. You will be issued a personalized selection date and time for you to log in to Badger Select and have the opportunity to move your seat location based on availability at the time of your selection. You will receive an email with your personalized selection date and time approx. one week prior to the start of Badger Select for men's hockey.

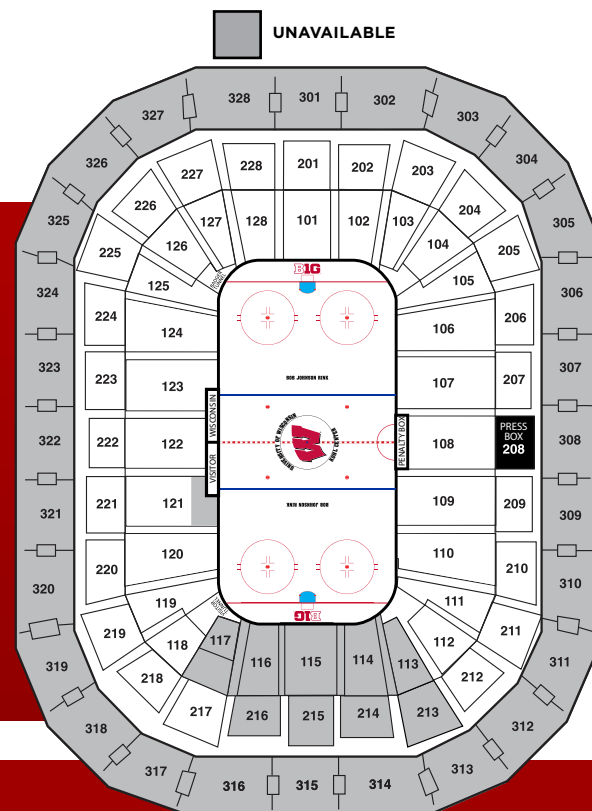

In 2024-25, the cut-off for allocation of a new parking permit in Lot 91 for both the Face-Off and Slap-Shot series was the Champion's Club (\$10,000) annual giving level.

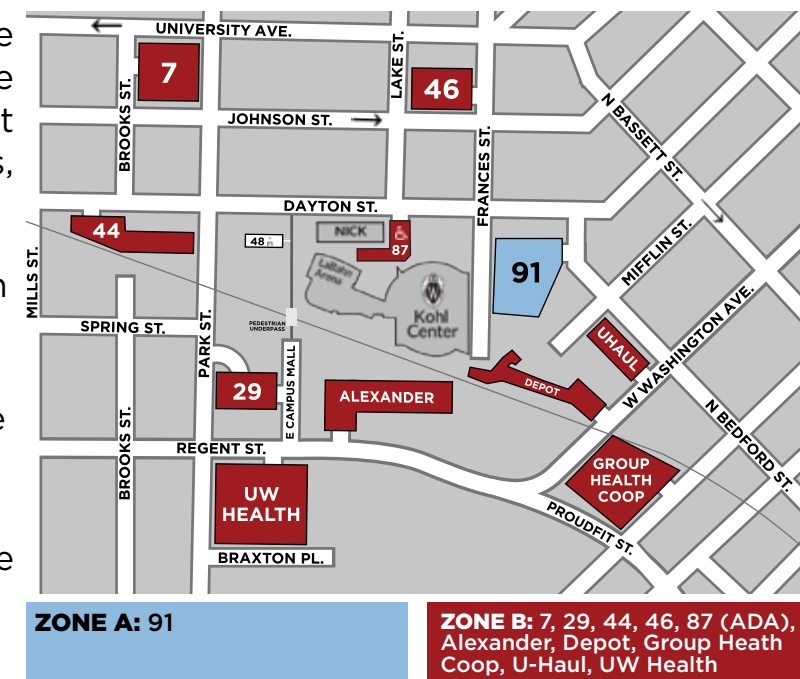

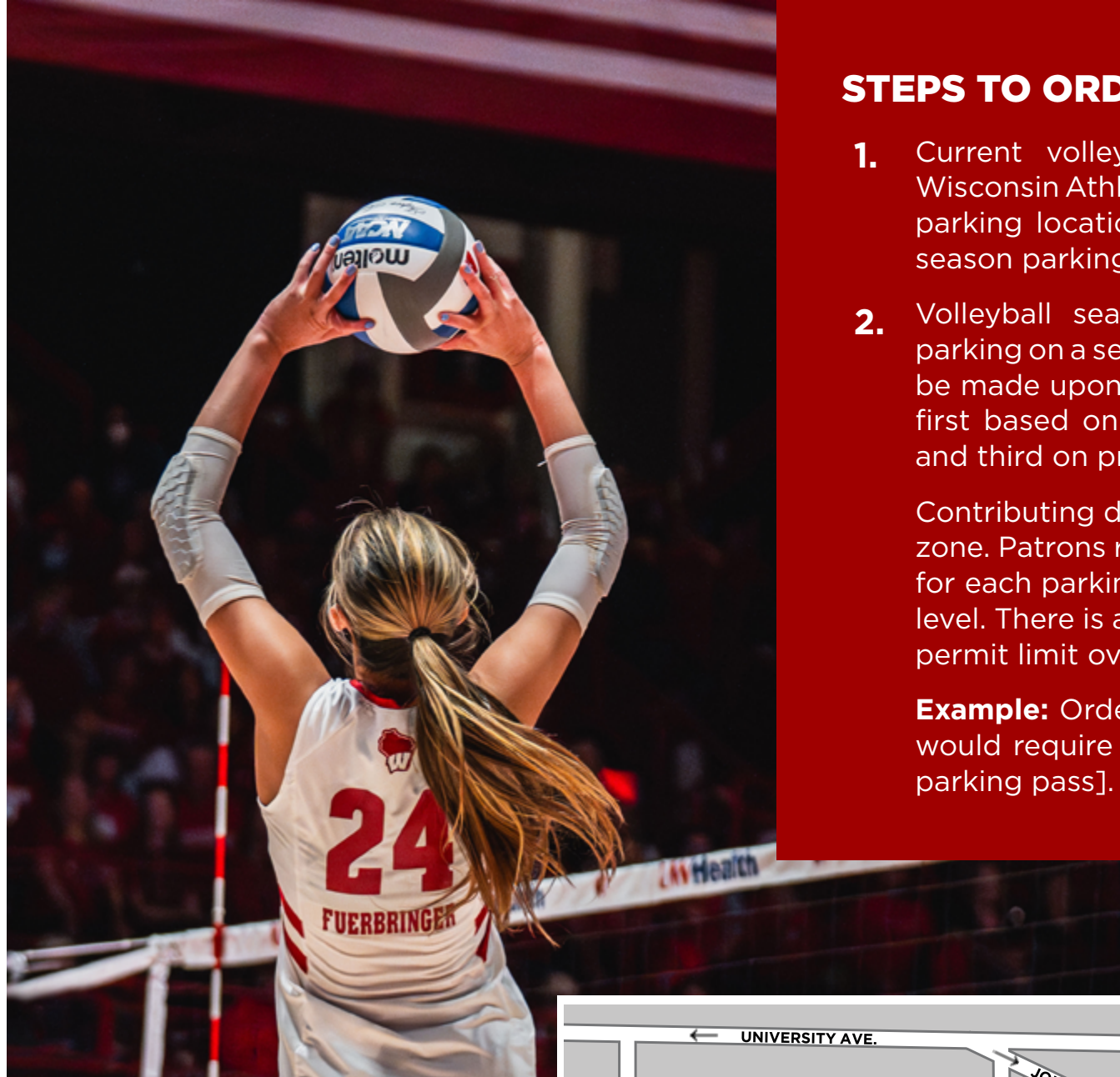

Beginning with the 2025 NCAA Volleyball Championship, if Wisconsin is selected to host the NCAA First and Second Round and/or Regional Round Tournament matches, per NCAA requirements, the team blocks of the four competing schools will be located in sections E, G, Q and S (previously sections D, H, P and T). Current volleyball season ticket holders requesting tickets will have reserved seating assignments allocated around the four competing team blocks based on Rank as of **October 31, 2025**.

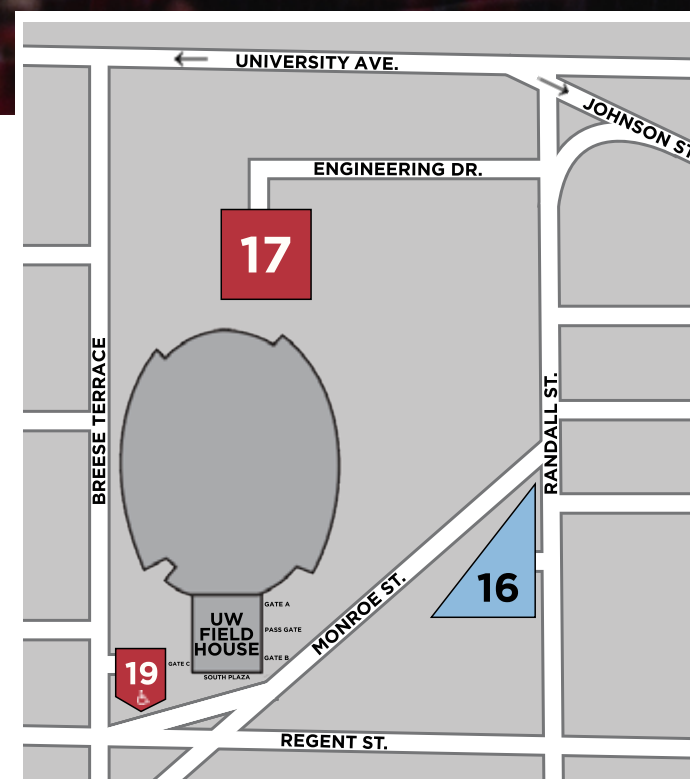

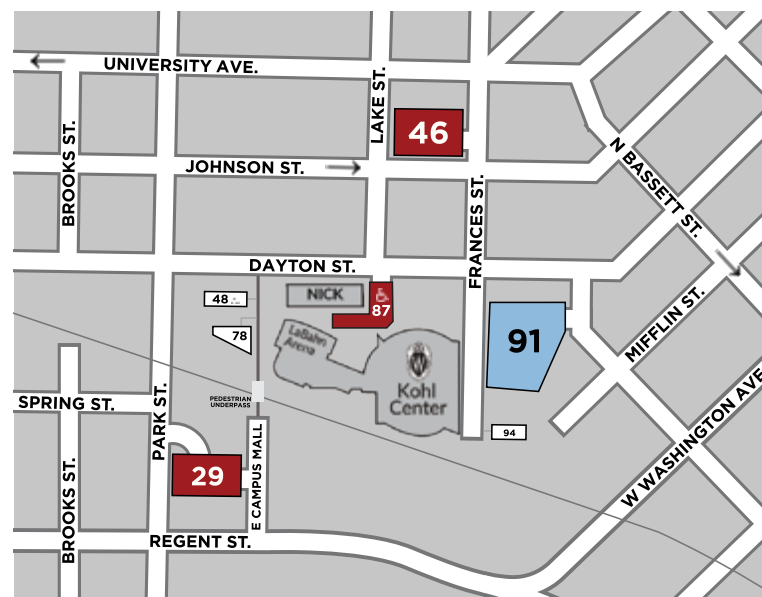

Parking for wrestling is available on a single-match basis. Fans may purchase parking in Lot 17 at the hourly rate, or in Lot 18 at the metered parking stalls only. Patrons with ADA needs may park in Lot 19.
